Presenter

Mr. Williams, a native Californian, is a graduate of the University of Southern California, earning a bachelor's degree of the Arts in 1968. He completed a master's degree in Education from California State University in Los Angeles while teaching the educationally handicapped in South El Monte, California from 1970-1973. In the mid-1970's, he experienced two years of post-graduate education in theological studies before beginning a twenty-three year professional career in church ministry in 1973.

A life skills educator and minister for thirty + years, Mr. Williams brings a rich professional background in public speaking, teaching and spiritual life discovery to the seven Passkeys life values that guide the foundation's programs. Those life values are: personal responsibility, positive self-worth, purpose, plan, paying the price, partnership and persistence.

Mr. Williams is the founder and president of Passkeys Foundation, a publicly supported foundation he created in 1979. The foundation is a 501(c) (3);509(a) (1) non-profit organization.

Since 1996, under Mr. Williams' full-time leadership, Passkeys Foundation has developed innovative values and character education programs for children, youth, adults and the business community. The programs currently include: the Mentoring For *Character* school site grants for elementary schools; the *Laws of Life* Essay Contest for middle schools; High School Ethics Project Grants for OC high schools. The foundation presents the ethical edge to the business and professional community, focusing on inspiring ethical excellence with programs, presentations, publications and podcasting.

Passkeys presents a 1 ½ hour parenting workshop, *The Finish Line*, Parenting To Build Kids of Character and a 1-hour parenting message with Q & A called *The 7 Parenting Promisessm*.

Mr. Williams writes a weekly *Letters On Integrity* article for Churm Media's online OC Metro Business Magazine and also publishes the article for two community newspapers in the San Gabriel Valley in Southern California and Boston, Massachusetts. Each weekly article is also sent to as a weekly newsletter to a foundation email list.

Mr. Williams serves on the Advisory Board of the Orange County Department of Education's Character Education Institute (ICE).

In 1999, Passkeys Foundation acquired through merger the Jefferson Center for Character Education, a non-profit organization founded in 1967. The Center was the pioneering organization in America in developing character education curricula with its *STAR* Responsibility Skills programs for elementary and middle schools.

Passkeys Foundation is a member of the national CHARACTER COUNTS! Coalition and the Character Education Partnership.

Russ and his wife, Judy, an elementary school teacher, have been married 41 years and have resided in Mission Viejo since 1986. They have four adult children and two grandchildren.
